The SAFE Award program was established by the MMS in 1983 to recognize and honor companies that make a concerted effort to train and motivate their employees to conduct offshore operations in a safe and environmentally responsible manner.

The agency recognizes both high OCS activity and moderate OCS activity categories for production.

Moderate activities are generally from a non-integrated, non-affiliated company.

Drilling and production contractors with exemplary OCS performance are also recognized, with winners being selected by each district office.

High activity SAFE Award winners are Energy Partners, Ltd, ChevronTexaco, Devon Energy Corporation and Devon Energy Production Company.

Moderate activity winners were Taylor Energy Company, EOG Resources and Energy Resource Technology.
