## **Subcommittee reports**

#### MPD - John Kozicz/Christian Stridsklev

Per Cato went through the status of the documents;

#### • Surface Backpressure - Surface BOP (92M)

Comments after ballot are processed and submitted to API. API has updated document. The committee has suggested some further updates but left it to API to evaluate which updates can be implemented without delaying issuing of the document

Roland Goodman informed that the normative references are only used when the document are required to be used (*shall*). He will remove the Normative references in both 92M &92P.

### • PMCD - Subsea BOP (92P)

Revised in September and sent to API. API has formatted the document and sent it back to committee with some questions which we have processed. API hope to get this out for ballot next month.

#### Surface Backpressure - Subsea BOP (92S)

The document was distributed to the group for comments (IADC internal), 531 comments were made. There are still 150 comments left that needs to be processed. The MPD task group will be concentrating on processing comments during their breakout sessions.

#### **UBO** – Mike Vander Staak and/or Dennis Moore

No work has been done since last meeting. The SBP documents have been priority.

## DGD – Børre Fossli (Dale Straub not present)

Work started to prepare a draft for Controlled Mud Level (CML) MPD RP. The intention is to have a break-out sessions during this meeting.

### Regulatory liaison - Earl Dietrich (not present).

New guidelines/rules have been issued by BSSE (safe drilling margin, etc), that might influence MPD operation. At the moment MPD & UBO needs exception that will be handled case by case. The committee will not do anything at the moment.

#### Well Control Liaison - Paul Sonneman

In the Q4 meeting the committee decided to hand over the "Gas in riser" document over to the IADC Well Control committee. Paul Sonnemann has handed this over in the last well control committee meeting, however it is uncertain if they will start working on the proposed document. Suggestion is that we could take the work on the "Gas in riser" document back to the committee. Work on this will need to be prioritized with other work the committee has taken on. Proposal is that Well Control liaison (Steve Kropla) should talk to Paul Sonnemann and/or Robert Ziegler to agree the way going forward.

#### Certifying Authority Liaison – CJ Bernard (not present)

ABS issued the final draft MPD document on march 28<sup>th</sup> MPD for comment. Comment should be sent by next Friday (April 22<sup>nd</sup>). ABS plan to issue the document soon (after having a meeting in Houston to discuss final comments).

#### API 16RCD - Martin Culen

Working on "Operational testing standard" for RCD. It will be addendum to API 16RCD.

## HSE / Training Subcommittee - Oscar Gabaldon and/or George Medley (not present)

Oscar informed that they aim to send out the updated MPD training curriculum to the committee before the Q3 meeting.

## **Any Other Topics**

- Antonio Torrealba gave a short summary of status of work in the subcommittee. A document called "Underbalanced Drilling and Managed Pressure Drilling Operations Using Jointed Pipe" (An Industry Recommended Practice (IRP) for the Canadian Oil and Gas Industry), has been updated. Proposal to appoint a liaison to follow up this Canadian work.
