- Significant discussion on whether leakage alone is capturing a successful pass/fail rate for regulators since these valves are more performance based than shuttle valves/SPMs
 - Does leakage need to be reported at beginning of test and end of test? What about deadband parameters?
 - Manufacturer needs to determine which values they feel comfortable reporting
