Presentation by RSHQ – Petroleum & Gas Inspectorate (Don Harris) and is attached.

- Incidents 2019/2020 Drilling Rigs (14), 11 Dangerous level
- Audits planned Noise
- Respirable Crystalline Silica (RCS) fracking outcomes from 2 years observations and sampling
- Inspection Priorities 20/21 Safety & Health
- Fall Protection and guarding examples of non-compliant
- Statistics:
 - o Active drilling rigs dropped from 17 to 10 during year
 - Active well servicing rigs dropped from 35 to 22 during year (40% drop in Industry)
 - Meters drilled increased from 626.5kms to 871kms from previous year.
 - Number of wells serviced increased from 4335 to 4879 wells from previous year.

Discussion Topics Offshore

- 1. Investigate ways to raise the profile of the association in WA and increase membership.
- Organise more meetings for members where matters of mutual interest could be discussed. There was general agreement to this, but we must develop a format.
- 3. Ensure the above meetings add value to IADC members and be a beneficial combination of business and social. To defray costs, look at cost-effective ways to structure sponsorship of meetings e.g., holding events in meeting room venues of member companies.
- 4. Above a result of the fact that Drilling Contractors are under tight financial controls these days.
- 5. Look into increasing Associate Membership (AM) and invite them to meetings allowing them to present at meetings, to give them added value for their membership. Martin to check with Chapter in Dubai how that works.
- 6. There was a discussion regarding whether people who are not members, being allowed to present, to entice them to take out membership.
- Look at ways to promote a positive side of the story in the drilling industry, in relation to the current climate change debate. Research with Curtin University if a Student Chapter is a possibility
- Maersk advised that they had recently had a team meeting about how they could promote employment opportunities in the industry to different public sectors, especially to young people.
- 9. Look into the West Australian Petroleum Club's School Program as a potential audience.
- 10. Utilise events of other WA drilling group events by providing relevant and beneficial industry information wherever possible for dispersion (e.g. Australian fixtures list).
