Training Providers seeking to obtain and maintain IADC accreditation for their DIT internal training course are subject to the following fees:

In-Person Audit Deposit NOTE: The audit deposit only covers a portion of the in-person audit fee. After the audit occurs, a post audit invoice will be sent with the audit administrative fee as well as any remaining audit fees and any audit expenses which may be incurred. Expenses may include costs associated with travel, travel time, lodging, meals, etc., and will vary depending on the location of the audit location. Due to this, the exact full cost of an in-person audit cannot be confirmed prior to audit.	\$900 USD	
Distance Audit Deposit NOTE: Under special circumstances and at IADC's discretion, audits may be conducted virtually instead of in-person. The audit deposit consists of the expected full cost of the audit.	\$950 USD

- Application fees: Payment of fees must be made at time of application. All applications are subject to the criteria and procedures specified in the Handbook for Accreditation (DIT-01). All application fees are non-refundable, even in the event the accreditation is denied or cancelled.
- Modifications: A fee will be charged for modifications made to an already accredited course that requires technical review.
- Audit Fees & Expenses: Audit costs are dependent upon the number of courses to be audited and provider location. Costs include: auditor's day rate fee, travel expenses, and an administrative fee. A multi-day audit may be required.
- Once accredited, the accredited provider is required to purchase and issue certificates to class participants that meet the requirements for the accredited course.
- Certificates are non-refundable and non-transferable between DIT and other accreditation programs.
- Providers must pay all IADC invoices within thirty (30) days to avoid interruption of Accreditation.
