Contributions or gifts to DRILLERSPAC are not deductible as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes. Corporate checks and credit cards are prohibited by federal law. Contribution amounts included herein are merely suggestions. An individual is free to contribute more or less than the guidelines suggest, but may not contribute more than \$5,000 per calendar year. Federal law requires that our committee report the full name, address, occupation and company name of each individual whose contributions aggregate in excess of \$200 in a calendar year. The Federal Election Campaign ACT (FECA) prohibits any foreign national from contributing, donating or spending funds in connection with any federal, state or local election in the United States, either directly or indirectly. It is also unlawful for U.S. citizens to assist foreign nationals in violating this law, or to solicit, receive or accept contributions or donations from them.
