• In-Person Audit Deposit NOTE: The audit deposit only covers a portion of the in-person audit fee. After the audit occurs, a post audit invoice will be sent with the audit administrative fee as well as any remaining audit fees and any audit expenses which may be incurred. Expenses may include costs associated with travel, travel time, lodging, meals, etc., and will vary depending on the location of the auditor in relation to the audit location. Due to this, the exact full cost of an in-person audit cannot be confirmed prior to audit.		\$1,000 USD

- Application fees: Payment of fees must be made at time of application. All applications are subject to
  the criteria and procedures specified in the Handbook for Accreditation (CAA-01). All application fees
  are non-refundable, even in the event the accreditation is denied or cancelled.
- Modifications: A fee will be charged for modifications made to an already accredited course that requires technical review.
- Audit Fees & Expenses: Audit costs are dependent upon the provider's location. Costs include: auditor's day rate fee, travel expenses, and an administrative fee. A multi-day audit may be required.
- Providers must pay all IADC invoices within thirty (30) days to avoid interruption of Accreditation.
