- A. Goal: fund up to Twenty (20) Scholarships.
 - 1. \$5,000 for each scholarship awarded.
 - 2. Scholarships to be funded in fall of 2025.
- B. Student requirements.
 - 1. Applicant must be a full-time student and a member in good standing of an IADC Student Chapter.
 - a. High school students who graduate in Spring 2025 are eligible to apply if they are admitted to their student chapter in the Fall of 2025.
 - 2. Applicant must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
 - 3. Applicant must submit the following in separate pdf documents:
 - a. Completed application form attached.
 - b. Current transcript(s) from secondary education institution (or high school, if freshman).
 - c. Current resume or C.V.
 - d. At least two letters of recommendation from faculty, community leaders or industry contacts. Form letters are not acceptable.
 - e. One-page personal essay on why you are pursuing your career path.
- C. Selection Criteria.
 - 1. Based on demonstrated qualities, including:
 - a) Academic success.
 - b) Leadership.
 - c) External focus (non-academic activities).
- D. Scholarship fund will pay directly to the school, for the following:
 - 1. Tuition
 - 2. Books
 - 3. Dorm fees
 - 4. Class Fees
 - 5. Any unused amount will be refunded to the IADC Student Chapter Scholarship Fund.
