## <u>Minutes</u>

**Call to Order:** The Vice Chair Isabela Louback (Precision Drilling) welcomed everyone in attendance to the Supply Chain Meeting.

### Safety Briefing/ Anti – Trust Guidelines/Administration

Thad Dunham (IADC liaison) provided emergency response information including muster points. He also reviewed the Anti-Trust Guidelines; wherein he emphasized the core of anti-trust law, and the required refrain from discussing pricing, dividing, allocating or boycotting suppliers or potential suppliers.

  by IADC. Following guidance from IADC's lobbyist, a formal exception request will not be
  submitted at this time.
  - Mark Shultz, President and CEO of CAOEC, shared insights from a recent successful exception request in Canada for drill pipe. He also mentioned about ongoing Canadian participation in the CUSMA/USMCA consultation work group, preparing for next year agreement extension.
- Inventory and Materials Management Subcommittee Vice Chair Fayad El Reda (Valaris) mentioned that the group will resume discussions on material preservation.
- **Networking and Learning Subcommittee** Chair **Marcello Goncalvez (Seadrill)** provided an update on the most recent networking event (happy hour).
